## Good Times Travel Health & Wellness Protocols

Your health, well-being, and enjoyment remain our top priority. Each guest that travels with us deserves a memorable and fulfilling travel experience. And we intend to continue to deliver on that promise we made almost 31 years ago.

To ensure a healthy and enjoyable travel experience we have additional health and wellness measures in place including:

- 1. All guests are required to sign the Wellness Pledge & Release of Liability Agreement prior to boarding the motorcoach.

  Please do not return the form to our office. Instead, print it, sign it and give it to your tour director prior to boarding the motorcoach. If you cannot print it or forget it, your tour director will have one for you to sign.
- 2. All guests, tour director, driver and step-on guides boarding the motorcoach must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 and must show proof of vaccination to the tour director and as required by venues while on tour. Proof of vaccination can be an official Vaccination Record Card, a photocopy or photo of the Vaccination Card or a digital vaccine record on a smartphone that shows the full name and dates of vaccine. While "fully vaccinated" is defined by the CDC as having received the primary series of vaccination (2 doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccine or 1 dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine) at least two weeks ago, it's highly recommended that all guests be "up-to-date" with any scheduled boosters as well.
- 3. All guests must travel with at least one face mask as specific municipalities and businesses may still require them and a federal transportation mask mandate can be reinstated without warning.
- 4. Hand sanitization is requested each time you board the motorcoach. Your tour director will have a supply of hand sanitizer or you may use your own. Please sanitize often and wash your hands whenever possible.
- 5. Those guests traveling solo may be seated in a pair of seats with another single guest (an adjacent empty seat can only be guaranteed for an additional fee).
- 6. Our local coach operator, *Lux Bus America*, equips their motorcoaches with MERV 13 air filters which remove respiratory droplets while the entire cabin is exchanged with fresh, outside air approximately 6 times per hour.
- 7. Our travel partners such as hotels, restaurants, attractions and guide services are following similar protocols and following guidelines provided by the CDC, state and county in which they do business.
- 8. We have enhanced our already high levels of training for our tour directors. These highly trained and knowledgeable individuals have the ability to handle a variety of unexpected situations including illnesses and emergencies. As always, your tour director is there to remove many of the "touch points" involved in travel including the hotel check-in and expedited entry into restaurants, museums and attractions.

While traveling with us, we recommend the following:

Along with the CDC and public health experts, we recommend and encourage our guests to wear face masks while onboard the motorcoach, airplanes, trains and in other indoor places where there are a number of people in close confines – even if a mask requirement may not be in place. Face masks, especially N95 masks – in addition to vaccination – provide the best protection against COVID-19, the flu, colds and other airborne illnesses.

Carry hand sanitizer with you and use it often in addition to washing your hands whenever possible.

Be prepared to follow all established health and wellness measures for the duration of the tour and ensure all members of your traveling party are prepared to do the same.

Keep in mind that our established measures may change due to this ever-changing environment we now live in and your tour director will provide the most up-to-date information.

Purchase travel protection, either through NTA/AON or through any other travel protection company – a small investment not only protects your funds, but provides countless benefits and peace of mind since travel protection can provide a full refund for specific reasons including illness or required quarantine.
